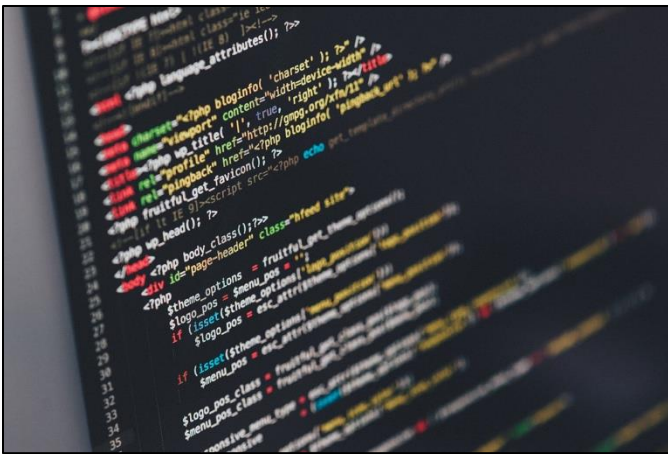
## Robust Analysis: Data and Intelligence
